

## Page Corner Bookmarks Beneficiary: HandsOn Broward Literacy Program

## Supply List\*

- Printed cardstock paper
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Mechanical pencil
- Glue stick
- Page Corner Bookmark Template (click the link)



## How to:

- 1. **Advise your network of the project.** Encourage your family, friends, and co-workers to donate their time creating this project.
- Purchase and/or collect supplies needed. Make sure you have enough to make 5 bookmarks to
  earn 2 service hours. We understand it may not be easy to access/purchase supplies at this time,
  so please do so safely. If you are having trouble, please contact us for suggestions.
  - PLEASE NOTE: We will only accept a maximum of 5 bookmarks per participant.
- 3. Create your page corner bookmarks. Detailed, step-by-step instructions are listed below.

## **Project Instructions:**

- 1. Gather your supplies. Be sure to print out your Page Corner Bookmark template.
- 2. Cut out your template pieces.
- 3. Trace your template onto your printed piece of cardstock (or onto the plain piece of cardstock that you intend to decorate), and cut the shape out.

4. Using your ruler and the tip of your mechanical pencil with no lead showing, score a line (make an indent) along the edges of the square that connect to the two triangles.



4.5 *Optional:* Cut a square of printed paper slightly smaller than the one you used for your template and glue it onto the square portion of your shape. We recommend you do this if the paper you're using is plain.




5. Fold one triangle inwards, so it covers the upper half of the square.





6. Apply glue to the underside (the side still facing up) of the second triangle, and fold it over onto the first triangle.





6.5 *Optional:* As in step 4.5, if you've used plain cardstock and want to glue printedpaper on top of it, cut out a triangle of the printed paper that's slightly smaller than the folded-over triangles of the bookmark. Glue the smaller triangle on top of the larger, folded-over ones.



7. Cut out the additional template pieces for the eyes and teeth. Use white cardstock for the teeth and largest circles for the eyes. Then use coordinating colors for the smaller eye circles. Or, be creative & pick your own colors! Glue to your bookmark and you'll see a cute monster face.
